7 Juanita High School's Rebels as Washington State Champions in
8 the Boys' Class AAA Basketball League, and

9 WHEREAS, the Rebels have the added distinction of being the
10 first KINGCO team to become State Champions in this division, and

12 established a new school record with 26 consecutive wins, and

14 excelling in athletics, but scholastic abilities as well, with a
15 cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.2, which is higher
