A MOTION recognizing May 20 - 26, 1984 as National Public Works Week in King County

WHEREAS, public works services provided by King County include programs for the design, construction and maintenance of a 2,639 mile road network and a system of 217 bridges, operation of King County International Airport, one of the busiest in the nation with 392,180 takeoffs and landings in 1983, operation of a solid waste system that disposed of 760,000 tons of solid waste in 1983, operation and control of a surface water drainage system that includes more than 900 miles of underground pipelines and 30,000 catchbasins, operation of five community sewer districts and management of the county's motor pool and its equipment rental fund, and

WHEREAS, the King County department of public works is responsible for a \$100 million Capital Improvement Program that over the next six years will provide for road system improvements, solid waste system improvements, improvements at King County International Airport, and improvements to the surface water management and flood control system, and

WHEREAS, the health, safety and comfort of our community greatly depend on these facilities and services, and

WHEREAS, the quality and effectiveness of these facilities, as well as their planning, design and construction are vitally dependent upon the efforts and skill of public works officials and employees;
