A MOTION recognizing A.H. Clise and his family for a significant contribution toward the preservation of the history of Willowmoor Farm at Marymoor Park.

WHEREAS, Marymoor Park is a regional facility providing recreational, historic, and educational opportunities for thousands of County residents every year, and

WHEREAS, a major portion of Marymoor Park was originally developed as an experimental farm by James W. Clise beginning in 1904, and by 1913 had become internationally known for its advanced agricultural methods, and

WHEREAS, the James W. Clise residence, in the heart of Marymoor Park and adjacent grounds and buildings, are listed on the National and King County Register of Historic Places as the Willowmoor Farm Historic District, and

WHEREAS, A.H. Clise (and members of the Clise family) have generously contributed to the cost of recently completed renovation work on the Clise Residence and windmill in the Willowmoor Historic District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A.H. Clise and the Clise family are honored and thanked for this significant contribution toward the preservation of the history of Willowmoor Farm at Marymoor Park.
