MOTION NO. 6045

1 A MOTION related to the acquisition of a  
2 computer system for the Green River Task Force;  
3 authorizing an emergency purchase pursuant to  
4 the provisions of K.C.C. 4.16.050.

5 WHEREAS, the legislature has appropriated \$200,000 for the  
6 acquisition of computer hardware and software for the purpose of  
7 assisting the Green River Task Force, and

8 WHEREAS, the executive has requested that the purchase of  
9 said equipment be executed on an emergency basis, and

10 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 4.16.050 requires that any emergency purchase  
11 in excess of \$50,000 be authorized by motion, and

12 WHEREAS, the Council recognizes that acquisition of the  
13 computer hardware and software through regular purchasing process  
14 will delay acquisition and thereby hamper the Green River Task  
15 Force in its investigation;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

17 The executive is authorized to acquire computer hardware and  
18 software in the amount of up to \$200,000 on an emergency basis  
19 for the Green River Task Force.
