2 A MOTION related to Transportation; requesting
3 the Transportation Commission to expedite
4 negotiations with Burlington Northern.

5 WHEREAS, the Soos Creek Community Plan and the North Soos
6 Creek Study identified the widening of SR-169 as a needed
7 transportation improvement, and

8 WHEREAS, the state department of transportation has taken the
9 lead in negotiation for acquisition of Burlington Northern
10 railroad right of way from Renton to Landsburg, and

11 WHEREAS, the W.S.D.O.T. schedule for the SR-169 widening
12 project anticipates project bid advertizement in January 1, 1985,
13 and

14 WHEREAS, negotiations between WSDOT and Burlington Northern
15 have not been completed, and

16 WHEREAS, King County currently owns 224 acres of park land
17 between the Cedar River and the Burlington Northern right of way;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

19 The Washington State Transportation Commission is requested
20 to expedite negotiations with Burlington Northern for the purpose
21 of acquiring railroad right of way between Renton and Landsburg
22 for the widening of SR-169 and the linkage of Renton and county
23 park lands along the Cedar River.
