

MOTION NO. 6085

A MOTION declaring the existence of an emergency requiring immediate repair of the Newport Hills Mudslide area and waiving the requirements for competitive bidding of the construction contract for such repair.

WHEREAS, a condition exists in a steep ravine in the Newport Hills Community that has created mudslides and erosion of the hillside, and

WHEREAS, approximately 22 homes located along the top of the ravine have been identified as subject to a substantial risk of damage or destruction during future periods of high rainfall and groundwater activity, and

WHEREAS, the County Council has, by Ordinance No. 6872 approved an emergency appropriation to fund the necessary repair work, and

WHEREAS, such repair work must begin immediately in order to allow as much work as possible to be completed during the present construction season so as to minimize the risk of personal injury and property damage, and

WHEREAS, the ordinary requirements for formal competitive bidding of the construction contract for such repair must be waived in order to prevent delay in beginning such repair work;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County Council declares that an emergency exists in the Newport Hills Mudslide area whereby the public interest would suffer material injury if necessary repair work is delayed.

3 are hereby waived.
