MOTION NO. 6096

A MOTION requesting the State Department of Transportation to allow Seattle City Light to use SR 509 right of way as a Transmission Line Route from the Highline/White Center area.

WHEREAS, Seattle City Light proposes to construct high voltage transmission lines to serve the Highline/White Center area, and

WHEREAS, the alternative routes considered all run through residential areas, and

WHEREAS, construction of high voltage transmission lines through residential areas subjects them to unnecessary visual blight and unnecessary risk from any break in the power lines, and

WHEREAS, an alternative route using right of way of SR 509 would not so directly impact residential areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Washington State Department of Transportation is requested to issue whatever permits are necessary to allow Seattle City Light to construct the required high voltage transmission lines within the right of way of SR 509.
