

MOTION NO. 6101

A MOTION authorizing the granting of  
an easement for a water meter

WHEREAS, the following described property is no longer necessary to the  
current needs of King County, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle has expressed a need for acquiring an  
easement to said property, and

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 36.34.130 provides for the disposition of county property  
to another governmental agency by means of private negotiations, and

WHEREAS, the King County executive has recommended that it is in the best  
interests of King County that said easement be granted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to dispose of the following property  
described as follows and to execute an easement in favor of the grantee as  
provided for in the attached easement.

Description:

An irregular tract located in Section 33, Township 24 North,  
Range 4 East, Willamette Meridian; situated in King County,  
Washington more particularly described as follows:

"Beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 33, Township 24  
North, Range 4 East, Willamette Meridian, thence along the  
Southerly boundary of Section 33, North 89°13'57" West a  
distance of 1314.13 feet; thence North 89°13'57" West 37.35  
feet to the Easterly right of way of East Marginal Way South;  
thence along said Easterly margin North 23°40'59" West 241  
feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence North 21°50'19"  
East 45 feet; thence North 68°09'41" West 10 feet; thence  
South 21°50'19" West 35.18 feet to the Easterly margin of  
East Marginal Way South; thence South 23°40'59" East 14.02  
feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; said tract of land  
contains 401 square feet, more or less."
