A MOTION to reconsider pre-effective condition 4 of the reclassification petitioned by ROBERT M. SHAY, ET. AL., designated Building and Land Development File No. 111-83-R and reclassifying the subject property to RD 3600-P.

WHEREAS, the county council adopted Ordinance 6785 on May 21, 1984, reclassifying certain property, designated building and land development file no. 111-83-R, from SR (Suburban Residential) to RD 3600-P, and

WHEREAS, a pre-effective condition of approval is a contract for the installation of a traffic control light by the Washington State Department of Transportation at the southbound ramp of N.E. 72nd Place and I-405, and

WHEREAS, circumstances prevent the satisfaction of these conditions within the time alloted by Ordinance 6785, and

WHEREAS, the criteria for reconsideration set forth in KCC 20.24.250 have been met and the county council desires to review and reconsider Ordinance 6785;
