2 A MOTION authorizing the execution of an
3 agreement under the Interlocal Cooperation Act,
4 Revised Code of Washington Chapter 39.34, between
5 King County and the U.S. Department of Justice's
6 Drug Enforcement Administration, for drug
7 enforcement.

8 WHEREAS, King County, State of Washington, discharges its
9 responsibility to furnish police service to its citizens by its
10 department of public safety ("the department") under the
11 authority of the county executive, and

12 WHEREAS, the department maintains its own drug enforcement
13 unit (D.E.U.) for controlled substances violation detection and
14 enforcement, and

15 WHEREAS, the United States Government discharges its
16 responsibilities in the drug enforcement field at least partially
17 through its Drug Enforcement Administration (D.E.A.), and

18 WHEREAS, cooperation between law enforcement agencies can
19 provide more efficient operations and mutual benefits, and

20 WHEREAS, the D.E.A. has a program whereby cooperative efforts
21 with local agencies can result in funds being available to such
22 local agencies, and

23 WHEREAS, the D.E.U. and D.E.A. are mutually desirous of
24 engaging in such a cooperative effort;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

26 The county executive is hereby authorized to contract with
27 the United State D.E.A. for the purpose of engaging in a
28 cooperative effort with the department's D.E.U.
