

MOTION NO. 6120

A MOTION proclaiming the week of
October 7 through October 14, 1984 as
"DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS WEEK."

WHEREAS, The King County Council is concerned and recognizes domestic violence as a continuing problem in King County, and

WHEREAS, King County has been supportive of efforts to deal with the problem by funding the King County Women's Program since 1978 which works closely with the Domestic Violence Coalition and publishing a list of countywide services.

WHEREAS, The week of October 7 through October 14, 1984 has been proclaimed National Domestic Violence Awareness Week, and

WHEREAS, The Washington State Domestic Violence Coalition will release the Domestic Violence Act Evaluation Project, a study evaluating criminal justice response to domestic violence in Washington state, in conjunction with National Domestic Violence Awareness Week, and

WHEREAS, The King County Council recognizes the efforts made to deal with the problem of domestic violence are in the best interests of all the citizens of King County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The week of October 7 through October 14, 1984 is hereby proclaimed "DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS WEEK" in King County.
