MOTION NO. 6130

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into interlocal agreements with various cities in King County for the purpose of establishing filing fees for certain criminal and traffic cases filed by such cities in district courts.

WHEREAS, RCW 3.62.070, as amended by Chapter 129, Laws of 1979, 1st Ex.

Sess., and by Chapter 128, Laws of 1980, 1st Reg. Sess., requires King County and various cities in King County to enter into interlocal agreements for the purpose of establishing a filing fee to be paid in certain criminal and traffic infraction actions filed in district court for ordinance violations.

WHEREAS, pursuant to existing interlocal agreements, King County and these various cities are desirous of establishing a filing fee in such cases at a mutually acceptable rate prior to the termination date of January 1, 1985 of existing interlocal agreements, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Motion No. 5587, the office of program development conducted a comprehensive district court filing fee study in 1983 to assess the relevant costs of processing municipal ordinance violations and the proposed filing fees for 1985 are consistent with the results of that study;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into interlocal agreements with cities pursuant to RCW 3.62.070, as amended by Chapter 129, Laws of 1979, 1st Ex. Sess., and by Chapter 128, Laws of 1980, 1st Reg. Sess., to establish filing fees for certain criminal and traffic infraction actions filed by such cities in King County district courts for ordinance violations,
- B. The King County Executive shall conduct a study, to be submitted to the Council by March 31, 1985, for the purpose of establishing filing fees for 1986 which will revise the current fee formula to include a projected inflation factor, allowable administrative costs and end-of-year adjustments to settle over and under payments due to projection and calculation errors.
