WHEREAS, the alternatives will be subject to a number of public meetings which should indicate whether the alternatives are more publicly acceptable than the executive proposed General Development Guide, and

- A. Motion 6062 is rescinded.
- B. The ad hoc committee formed pursuant to Motion 6062 is hereby reconstituted. The ad hoc committee shall consist of representatives of the development industry, environmental interests and the executive task force. The members of said eighteen-member ad hoc committee shall be comprised of two individuals named by each of the nine members of the county council. The ad hoc committee shall be brought together to review and comment on the Guide and alternatives under consideration.
- C. The committee shall report to the P&CD Committee at its first meeting in January, 1985 with recommendations as to all matters on which it agrees, and identifying significant matters on which it cannot agree.
