

MOTION NO. 6134

A MOTION accepting the Urban Parks and Recreation Recovery (UPARR) Program which contains an analysis and discussion of King County parks and recreation division and presents strategies the division intends to use in meeting residents' parks and recreation needs.

WHEREAS, the King County parks and recreation division has received funding from the U.S. Department of the Interior National Park Service under the Urban Parks and Recreation Recovery (UPARR) Program for parks projects on the White Center Activity Center and Preston Snoqualmie trail, and

WHEREAS, the King County parks and recreation division was required, as a condition of that funding, to develop and implement a recovery action program, and

WHEREAS, the King County parks and recreation division has developed and is implementing a recovery action program; and

WHEREAS, the King County parks and recreation division has submitted its recovery action program to the King County Council for its review and comments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The recovery action program submitted by the King County parks and recreation division is accepted and recommended for transmittal to the National Park Service.

Provided that:

This report will be used as a general guide by the Parks Division for proposed park capital and operating improvements. These recommendations will be considered in the context of the budget, appropriate land use plans and other relevant plans and studies authorized by the council.
