MOTION NO. 6135

A MOTION to authorize the granting of a public water supply system easement to the City of Kent in Council District 9.

WHEREAS, The City of Kent has made application for the right to construct operate and maintain a public water supply system, together with all necessary or reasonable appurtenances over, through, under, across and upon the land described herein, and

WHEREAS, this construction of a public water supply system on King County land is necessitated by the City of Kent to increase a current insufficient public water supply, and

WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it would be appropriate to grant this easement for good and valuable consideration, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary public water supply system easement granting to the City of Kent an easement for a public water supply system with all necessary or reasonable appurtenances over, through, under, across and upon the following described property, situate in King County, Washington:

The southerly 30.00 feet and the westerly and northerly 200.00 feet, measured parallel with the easterly and southerly bank of the White River (also know as Green River) as it now exists, of the following described property:

Lot "B" of C.D. Hillman's Auburndale, Division #1, vol. 13 of plats, page 62, records of King County, Washington; together with a portion of Government Lot 8, Section 7, Township 21 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in said county, also a portion of Government Lot 5, Section 8, Township 21 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in said county; both portions lying southerly and easterly of the White River (also known as Green River) and northerly of Lot 16 in Block 9 of plat of Auburndale Division #1, vol. 13 of plats, page 62, records of King County.
