A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into agreements with suburban cities for the purpose of preserving historic landmarks in King County.

WHEREAS, King County recognizes the unique value of historic landmarks within suburban cities; and

WHEREAS, King County has adopted numerous policies and plans providing for the preservation of historic landmarks; and,

WHEREAS, King County has established by Ordinance 4828 a mechanism for designating historic landmarks and has established a landmarks commission; and,

WHEREAS, King County recognizes that a joint and cooperative agreement provides the best opportunity for the effective implementation of those adopted plans and policies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into and carry out the provisions of an agreement, in substantially the same form as is attached, by and between King County and suburban cities for the purpose of preserving historic landmarks in King County.
