A MOTION certifying land use consistency for a connection to the METRO Issaquah Interceptor by the City of Issaquah.

WHEREAS, METRO Resolution 2933 requests King County to certify METRO connections as consistent with plans and policies, and

WHEREAS, the City of Issaquah has asked to connect to METRO's Issaquah Interceptor to serve a residential development wholly within its city limits, and

WHEREAS, this connection could provide sewer service to a greater area than is presently authorized by the Newcastle Community Plan, and

WHEREAS, this excess capacity could serve part of the area proposed for (1) the Cougar Mountain Regional Wildlands Park and (2) the potential East Village of the Newcastle Community Plan, and

WHEREAS, the unincorporated county area which could be served is inappropriate for sewers, as shown by Newcastle Plan Policies N-1, N-2, N-34, N-36, N-44, N-49, N-50, N-51 and N-52, and

WHEREAS, part of the unincorporated area to be sewered includes sensitive areas, steep slopes, and wetlands, and

WHEREAS, the sewer service should be restricted to properties within the City of Issaquah;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The Terra Highlands Connection to METRO's Issaquah Interceptor is certified as consistent with King County land use plans and policies, Provided that: sewer service is limited to serve properties within the City of Issaquah.
