A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$32,517 to support a Boating Safety Program Grant File No. 503.

WHEREAS, the Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission is empowered to make grants to support educational, training, and enforcement programs relating to boating safety, and

WHEREAS, the Boating Safety Program will assist the county to improve the capabilities of the Marine Patrol section to provide educational and training services and improve patrol and accident response activities, and

WHEREAS, the council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$32,517 as an in-kind contribution in support of the project, and

WHEREAS, the council considers this obligation to be satisfied through currently budgeted funds for the county's existing marine patrol program; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$32,517 to the Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission for a Boating Safety Program on behalf of King County;
- The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
- The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
- D. The Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
