A MOTION authorizing the county executive to enter into a contract with Boeing Military Airplane Company for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a communications ductbank in Council District 5

WHEREAS, The Boeing Military Airplane Company has filed an application in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010 for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a communications system, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the county executive for investigation of the feasibility thereof, and

WHEREAS, the county executive has recommended approval of the franchise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to enter into and execute the attached communications ductbank franchise contract dated March 26, 1984, in the upper left hand corner, for the Boeing Military Airplane Company, which by this reference is incorporated herein as part of the Motion. Said franchise is granted to the Boeing Military Airplane Company, for the term of twenty five (25) years, said franchise to include all of the terms and conditions required by the county.

If within thirty (30) days after the granting of this franchise the applicant shall have failed to sign the incorporated written acceptance herein, then the herein granted rights and privileges shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
