## MOTION NO. 6224

A MOTION authorizing the signing of a License Agreement from Pierce County and King County, Washington to the United States of America, Seattle District Corps of Engineers.

WHEREAS, in 1981 the Pierce County Commissioners and the King County executive executed an easement deed to the Corps of Engineers to maintain a stream gauging station on a portion of property owned by the Inter-County River Improvement District along the Puyallup River in Pierce County, and

WHEREAS, the easement deed warranted title and agreed to hold the Corps of Engineers harmless, and

WHEREAS, the matter was reviewed and because of objections to the deed it was cancelled and the Corps of Engineers has been anxious to cover the stream gauging station with some kind of instrument, and

WHEREAS, the Corps of Engineers has presented a License Agreement to cover the location and maintenance of the stream gauging station that has been accepted and signed by Pierce County and approved by the King County surface water management division.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive be authorized to sign the License Agreement covering the property described as follows:

A 25-foot strip of land lying on the left bank Tract No. 301E: of, and within the Puyallup River right-of-way in the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter (NE 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 20, Township 20 North, Range 4 East, Willamette Meridian, Pierce County, Washington. Said strip being coincident to the northeasterly right-of-way of State Highway No. 5 (now State Highway No. 410) and lying 15 feet northwesterly and 10 feet southeasterly of the following described line.

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BEGINNING at a point on the above described highway right-of-way at right angles to Centerline Station 145+90+ on said highway; thence northeasterly to the TERMINUS of the described strip on the centerline of the Puyallup River right-of-way at Centerline Station 207+22±. EXCEPTING THEREFROM all those lands lying northeasterly of the left bank line of ordinary high water. ALSO EXCEPTING THEREFROM a strip of land 6 feet wide within the Puyallup River right-of-way, said strip being coincident to the northeasterly right-of-way of said highway No. 5 and extending southeasterly 30 feet.
