MOTION NO. 6228

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to submit a grant application to the United States Economic Development Administration to fund public facility improvements in the Kenmore Commercial/Industrial Center.

WHEREAS, the United States Economic Development Administration, under the authority of the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965, Public Law 89-136, provides funding for public improvements which stimulate long-term private sector investment and job creation, and

WHEREAS, the King County Northshore Community Plan identifies Kenmore as a commercial and industrial center for economic development, and

WHEREAS, inadequate public water supply and road facilities are presently restricting private commercial and industrial development in the Kenmore Commercial/Industrial Center, and

WHEREAS, the King County department of public works, in coordination with the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District and the Kenmore business community, is proposing water and road improvements, known as the Kenmore Redevelopment Project, to stimulate private sector investment and job creation in the Kenmore Commercial/Industrial Center, and

WHEREAS, the Kenmore Redevelopment Project is consistent with the Northshore Community Plan, the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District Plan, and the Public Works and Economic Development Act, and

WHEREAS, the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District Board of Commissioners has enacted Resolution 1983-6-2 endorsing their participation in the Kenmore Redevelopment Project, and

WHEREAS, the King County council has previously enacted legislation in the form of King County Motions 5193 and 5759 in support of water and road improvements to stimulate economic development in the Kenmore Commercial/ Industrial Center, and

WHEREAS, the 1985-1990 King County Capital Improvements Program includes \$232,744 in road improvements for the Kenmore Redevelopment Project, and

WHEREAS, the Central Puget Sound Economic Development District on May 17, 1984 identified the Kenmore Redevelopment Project as its number one regional priority for 1985 funding by the Economic Development Administration, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration on February 6, 1985 formally invited King County to submit a grant application by March 18, 1985 to fund the Kenmore Redevelopment Project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$510,021 to the Economic Development Administration for improvements to water and road systems in the Kenmore Commercial/Industrial Center on behalf of King County;
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such applications and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor; and
