MOTION NO. 6246

A MOTION authorizing interlocal agreements between King County and five cities in King County for the provision of marine patrol services, and authorizing the County Executive to execute such interlocal agreements.

WHEREAS, the county has established and maintains a Marine Patrol Unit designed to provide marine patrol service to the waters of unincorporated King County, and

WHEREAS, the county is capable of extending marine patrol service into the waters under the jurisdiction of cities, and

WHEREAS, five cities desire to obtain marine patrol service from the county to accomplish law enforcement in their respective waters;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Pursuant to RCW 39.34.080, it is hereby agreed that the county executive is authorized to enter into interlocal agreements to provide marine patrol service to the cities of Bellevue, Kirkland, Redmond, Hunts Point, and Yarrow Point.
