MOTION NO. 6320

A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$1,015,754 to enhance King County's capabilities to identify, apprehend and prosecute violent criminal offenders in general and the Green River killer(s) in particular, Grant File No. 511.

WHEREAS, the Justice Assistance Act of 1984, as amended, provides for the award of block grants by the department of justice to states for improving the criminal justice system with emphasis on violent crimes and serious offenders, and

WHEREAS, the state department of community development is empowered to make grants to units of local government under the Justice Assistance Act of 1984, and

WHEREAS, enhancement of King County's law enforcement capabilities will assist the county in meeting the needs of the public for protection from violent crimes, and

WHEREAS, the council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$1,015,754 as an in-kind contribution in support of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$1,015,754 to the department of community development to enhance King County's capabilities to identify, apprehend and prosecute violent criminal offenders in general and the Green River killer(s) in particular;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

D. The department of justice and state department of community development are hereby assured full compliance with title VI of the Civil Rights Act.

E. All new positions funded from grant funds provided herein shall not be considered permanent and shall not continue to be funded from Current Expense Funds once grant monies are no longer available.
