MOTION NO. 6333

A MOTION authorizing an Interlocal Agreement between King County and King County Water and Sewer District No. 82 to restore the water quality of Pine Lake.

WHEREAS, a management team comprised of a representative of King County and King County Water and Sewer District No. 82 have developed the Interlocal Agreement, and

WHEREAS, the proposed Interlocal Agreement would provide for the design, right-of-way acquisition, construction, inspection, and maintenance of a diversion structure and approximately 1500 feet of buried culvert, and

WHEREAS, this diversion will intercept nutrient laden surface water runoff from the bog in the southwestern portion of the Pine Lake Basin and divert the normal water flow directly to the outlet to significantly reduce the eutrophication of Pine Lake, and

WHEREAS, a study will be funded and performed by others to monitor and evaluate the project's effectiveness;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with King County Water and Sewer District No. 82 for a project and study to restore the water quality of Pine Lake upon the terms specified in the Interlocal Agreement, which is attached as Exhibit 1.
