A MOTION relating to the Arts Commission Festival of New Works - Performa '87 - and expressing Council support for the program.

*WHEREAS, the King County Arts Commission is preparing for a major festival of new works in 1987 on the occasion of the $\angle 0$ th Anniversary of the Commission, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the festival is to produce and promote world premieres of new work which fosters the highest artistic quality, generates national media attention, stimulates cultural education and excitement, and involves the citizens, tourists, business and arts communities of the northwest, and

WHEREAS, the festival is intended to assist King County arts organizations and independent artists with the commissioning, 'presentation and promotion of new works, and

WHEREAS, the festival is intended to increase local public awareness of new works through an educational campaign, and

WHEREAS, it is also intended to encourage positive interaction between the government, business and arts communities, and

WHEREAS, the executive committee of the festival includes some of Seattle's most prominent civic, business and cultural leaders, and

WHEREAS, the executive committee will be assisted by a resource group of twenty-five members composed of Seattle's leaders in the arts, marketing and business communities, and

WHEREAS, members of the national jury include artists with national reputations in the arts such as Trisha Brown, Robert Joffrey, George Coates, Philip Glass and Brendan Gill, and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the new works festival is expected to be \$1.2 - \$1.4 million including in-kind contributions from arts organizations, contributions from other governmental jurisdictions and art commissions, the National Endowment for the Arts, private organizations and business, and

WHEREAS, the King County council has appropriated \$20,000 and \$85,000 in 1984 and 1985, respectively, to support the development of the festival and will be requested to appropriate \$85,000 and \$115,000 in 1986 and 1987, respectively, to further support the festival.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The council recognizes the importance of the New Works

Festival - Performa '87 - and intends to support appropriation requests from the arts commission to support the festival in 1986 and 1987.
