WHEREAS, the review process carefully examined detailed descriptions of programs, policies and practices provided by the schools and included site visits that consisted of interviews with students, parents, teachers, support staff and district administrators, and

WHEREAS, Mount Rainier High School achieved or exceeded the fifteen attributes of successful schools, and

WHEREAS, those fifteen attributes included among others; clear academic goals, high expectations for students, order and discipline, concentration of academic learning time, and both teacher and administrative leadership, and

WHEREAS, this national recognition of Mount Rainier High School brings honor to the Highline School District No. 401 and instills pride in the citizens of King County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
