A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to accept a grant award of \$186,015 from the State of Washington Office of Financial Management to offset the cost impact of enhanced enforcement of laws prohibiting driving while intoxicated.

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, by the adoption of Substitute Senate Bill 3656, Section 121(4), allocated \$1 million for grants to cities and counties to offset the costs of prosecution and adjudication of DWI and physical control offenses, during the period from July 1,1985 to February 28, 1986, and

WHEREAS, King County has been awarded such a grant for the use of the office of the prosecuting attorney and for the King County District Courts, and

WHEREAS, the office of the prosecuting attorney would renew grant funding for two deputy prosecuting attorneys and King County District Courts would renew grant funding for 6.5 probation counselors and 2 full-time clerical support staff, and

WHEREAS, the cost impact of DWI and physical control prosecution and adjudication can be mitigated by accepting funding from the State of Washington;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to accept the grant award from the State of Washington, Office of Financial Management, for state funds to offset the cost impact of enhanced enforcement of DWI and physical control prosecution and adjudication.

3	upon the continued availability of state funds.
