A MOTION relating to an Urban Development Action Grant (UDAG) application from the City of Carnation to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), supporting Carnation's application for a UDAG for Tolt Towne Center.

WHEREAS, economic development is a priority of the King County executive and the King County council, and

WHEREAS, a public economic development program is defined as those public actions which help to promote an improved local economy and business environment, and

WHEREAS, economic development strategies are those public actions which aid in creating jobs, enhancing general business activity, and increasing communities' tax bases, increasing per capita income, and

WHEREAS, King County has previously recognized in Motion 6012 that the retention of existing businesses and the expansion of existing businesses and the revitalization of existing communities is a priority, and

WHEREAS, the King County executive proposed and the King County council funded the 1985 Business Revitalization Project, and

WHEREAS, one of the elements of the Business Revitalization Project is the identification of and packaging of UDAG grants for King County communities and King County staff have prepared the UDAG application for Carnation, and

WHEREAS, Carnation is identified as a rural activity center in the King County Comprehensive Plan - 1985, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Carnation and Carnation City Council and developers, the Michon Corporation, have worked together to propose the Tolt Towne Center project which will revitalize downtown Carnation, and

WHEREAS, the UDAG grant of \$220,000 is necessary and appropriate to develop the \$1.5 million shopping center and to create 53 jobs;
