A MOTION requesting the suburban cities to contribute toward the costs of funding the King County Rape Relief Program.

WHEREAS, King County Rape Relief has been serving victims of sexual assault since 1974, and

WHEREAS, King County government and a number of the suburban cities have provided continual monetary support to this agency in the past, and

WHEREAS, fifty-five percent (55%) of the funds for King County Rape Relief come from fund raising, private sector donations, and sales of literature, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for local governments to provide the balance or forty-five percent (45%) of the funding for this agency, and

WHEREAS, fifty-one percent (51%) of the victims served by this agency come from unincorporated King County, and

WHEREAS, King County government intends to increase its funding share to \$65,000 which equals fifty-one percent (51%) of local governments' share, and

WHEREAS, twenty-one percent (21%) of the victims served by this agency come from the suburban cities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The King County council and executive call upon the suburban cities to contribute toward the funding for 1986 and subsequent budget years to the King County Rape Relief Program.
