

MOTION NO. 6396

2 A MOTION authorizing the county executive to execute an  
3 interlocal agreement between King County and the City of  
4 Seattle providing for distribution of boat tax revenues.

5 WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature, in enacting Chapter 3, Laws of  
6 1983 and Chapter 7, Laws of 1983, 2nd Ex. Sess., hereafter referred to as the  
7 "1983 State Boating Law," recognized the need for a new funding source for  
8 local marine patrol services for pleasure boaters, and

9 WHEREAS, the 1983 State Boating Law authorizes counties to levy a tax on  
10 certain pleasure boats of up to fifty cents (\$.50) per foot, hereafter  
11 referred to as the "tax," to pay for marine patrol services, and

12 WHEREAS, the effects of the 1983 State Boating Law provisions are to  
13 require the county and the city to enter into an interlocal agreement under  
14 Chapter 39.34 Revised Code of Washington (RCW) prior to enacting the tax and  
15 to consider in such interlocal agreement any marine patrols provided as of  
16 June 30, 1983, and

17 WHEREAS, in 1984 the county and the city signed such an interlocal  
18 agreement, which remains effective until December 31, 1985, and the county  
19 is collecting the tax pursuant to King County Ordinance 6595 as amended by  
20 Ordinance 6734 (KCC CH. 12.45), and

21 WHEREAS, the tax will expire on December 31, 1985, unless the interlocal  
22 agreement signed in 1984 is succeeded by another interlocal agreement, and

23 WHEREAS, King County desires to extend the imposition of the tax at least  
24 through 1988, consistent with the 1983 State Boating Law and any succeeding  
25 amendments enacted by the Legislature, and

1 WHEREAS, the county and the city have agreed to the terms of an  
2 interlocal agreement to authorize the tax through 1988,

3 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


4 Pursuant to RCW 39.34.080, the county executive is authorized to execute  
5 an interlocal agreement with the City of Seattle providing for distribution of  
6 local option boat tax revenues between 1986 and 1988.
