A MOTION authorizing the acceptance of funds allocated to King County by the Washington State Centennial Commission.

WHEREAS, in 1984, the King County council passed Motion No. 5972 calling for the formation of a "King County Centennial '89 Advisory Committee," and

WHEREAS, in 1985, the historic preservation office was directed by the executive and council to hold a series of workshops about the state's upcoming centennial in 1989, and

WHEREAS, 300 people attended six centennial workshops held by the office of historic preservation in May through July of 1985, and

WHEREAS, the state centennial commission has established a small funding program to assist counties with their centennial activities, and

WHEREAS, Jean Gardner, co-chairman of the centennial commission and chair of the commission's local celebrations committee has sent a letter and contract about payments which will be administered through contractual arrangements with each county government or its designee;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County council endorses the historic preservation office to enter into a contract with the Washington Centennial Commission to receive funds which the state has allocated to assist counties with their centennial activities.
