MOTION NO. 6407

A MOTION accepting the Preliminary Assessment of Water Supply and Fire Protection Issues in King County; declaring Critical Water Supply Areas; authorizing the Executive to enter into interlocal agreements to prepare Coordinated Water Supply Plans, requesting supplemental budget proposals for a Fire Service Master Plan, a Water Resource Management Program and Coordinated Water Supply Plans for South King County, Skyway and Vashon.

WHEREAS, the King County council passed Motion 5701 on March 7, 1983 initiating preparation of a Preliminary Assessment of Water Supply and Fire Protection Issues in King County, and

WHEREAS, the Preliminary Assessment has been completed and recommends preparation of three Coordinated Water Supply Plans, a Fire Service Master Plan and a Water Resource Management Program, and

WHEREAS, preparation of Coordinated Water Supply Plans may require execution of interlocal agreements with participating agencies, and

WHEREAS, implementation of the Assessment's recommendations requires supplemental appropriations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The Preliminary Assessment of Water Supply and Fire Protection Issues prepared in response to Motion 5701 is accepted.

B. The recommendations contained in Chapter II of the Preliminary Assessment are generally acceptable, but require additional review to assure that the concerns of other agencies are incorporated; and to further assure consistency with county plans and policies. The subsequent review of the recommend-

1 ations should be completed and the revised recommendations
2 submitted to the Transportation and Facilities Committee for
3 consideration by March 1, 1986.

4 C. Pursuant to Chapter 70.116 R.C.W. Critical Water Supply
5 Areas for South King County, Skyway and Vashon (as
6 preliminarily mapped in the Preliminary Assessment) are hereby
7 declared. The executive is hereby authorized to notify the
8 Department of Social and Health Services and to form Water
9 Utility Coordinating Committees pursuant to Chapter 70.116.040
10 R.C.W. for the purpose of preparing Coordinated Water Supply
11 Plans for the areas described above.

12 D. The executive is hereby authorized to enter into an
13 interlocal agreement (substantially in the form attached) with
14 the Regional Water Association of South King County for the
15 purpose of preparing a Coordinated Water Supply Plan.

16 E. The executive is hereby requested to prepare and submit
17 to the county council work programs and supplemental budget
18 proposals for the three designated Critical Water Supply Areas,
19 the Fire Service Master Plan and the Water Resource Management
20 Program by December 31, 1985.
