A MOTION requesting the Puget Sound Council of Governments to expedite their review of policies related to disposal of demolition and landclearing debris.

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Board is about to undertake a revision of the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan, and

WHEREAS, the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan currently assigns responsibility for disposal of demolition and landclearing debris to the private sector, and

WHEREAS, the Newcastle Landfill, a private operation is presently the only available site in King County for disposal of demolition and landclearing debris, and

WHEREAS, the life of the Newcastle Landfill is uncertain and limited, and

WHEREAS, failure of the private sector to provide disposal facilities for land clearing and demolition debris would require King County and other municipalities to provide such sites,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Puget Sound Council of Governments is requested to make review of policies related to the responsibility for disposal of
