A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to relocate a King County road by exchanging King County real property for real property owned by H. Leigh Hill pursuant to a request by the latter to the county.

WHEREAS, Mr. Hill owns property on each side of a dedicated road owned by King County in the plat of Rosehilla Beach Addition, and

WHEREAS, said road constitutes public access to and abuts on a body of water, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hill is entitled to separately improve each of his lots, and

WHEREAS, such improvements do not reflect the intent of the current zoning classification, and

WHEREAS, to remedy this situation Mr. Hill has proposed to deed King County approximately 3,163 square feet of land in exchange for 3,118 square feet of King County road right of way, and

WHEREAS, King County cannot vacate rights of way abutting bodies of water pursuant to RCW 36.87.130, and

WHEREAS, this property exchange is in the best public interest toward a more orderly future development of this area, and

WHEREAS, the property to be exchanged is similar in character and utility to the public, and

WHEREAS, an appraisal has been performed on the parcels to be exchanged and that the value of said parcels is relatively equal, and

WHEREAS, the area of the parcels to be exchanged is virtually equal;
NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to proceed with and execute a land exchange in the public's best interest as follows:

Parcel "A" (To King County):

The Southeasterly 16 feet of Lot 1, Block 1 Rosehilla Beach Addition, as per plat recorded in Volume 20 of Plats, page 9, records of King County, Washington.
