A MOTION relating to council committees  
and introduction of proposed legislation.

WHEREAS, the council organizes to conduct business through a  
structure of committees, and

WHEREAS, each committee has a chair responsible for the  
conduct of its meetings, and

WHEREAS, one of the primary responsibilities of a committee  
is to review proposed legislation and make recommendations to  
the council thereon, and

WHEREAS, introduction of proposed legislation by a council-  
member for referral to the appropriate committee or action by  
the council is a step in the legislative process necessary to  
formal consideration, and

WHEREAS, introduction does not represent endorsement of the  
proposed legislation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Proposed legislation may be introduced by any councilmember.  
Ordinarily proposed legislation will be introduced by the  
appropriate committee chair unless introduced by the district  
representative. Proposed legislation to be heard by the zoning  
and subdivision examiner will customarily be introduced by the  
chair of the planning, housing & community development committee.
