MOTION NO. 6502

A MOTION requesting the Executive to furnish certain information in preparation for formation of a Park and Recreation Service Area.

WHEREAS, RCW 36.68.400 provides for the creation of park and recreation service areas for the purpose of financing the acquisition, construction, improvement, maintenance or operation of park and recreational facilities, and

WHEREAS, the City of Issaquah has requested that the council authorize an election to form a park and recreation service area to include the City of Issaquah and certain portions of King County which surround the City of Issaquah, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a community center for the use of residents within the proposed service area boundaries, and

WHEREAS, there may be other county park projects within the boundaries of the proposed service area which could benefit from inclusion in the proposal, *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Issaquah has requested that the park and recreational service area proposal be placed on the ballot of the September 16, 1986 election for voter approval;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby requested to provide the following information pertaining to the proposed Issaquah Park and recreation service area to the council by May 1, 1986:

A. Proposed boundaries,

B. Proposed statement of purpose,

C. Estimated costs of proposed projects, including land, capital improvements, maintenance and operations,

1 D. Analysis of the benefits of the proposed community
2 center to the King County residents within the proposed service
3 area boundaries,

4 E. Estimated costs of forming the proposed service area,

5 F. Description of the relationship of the proposed service
6 area to King County's park system, including an analysis of the
7 feasibility of the proposed service area,

8 G. Relationship of this proposal to other possible park
9 and recreation service areas,

10 H. Proposed method of financing and financial plan for the
11 proposal,

12 I. Draft interlocal agreement needed to implement the
13 service area.
