MOTION NO. 6553

A MOTION authorizing the county executive to enter into a contract with the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain an effluent transfer system in Council District 8.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle has filed an application in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010 for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain an effluent transfer system, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the county executive for investigation of the feasibility thereof, and

WHEREAS, the county executive has recommended approval of the franchise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED, by the Council of King County:

A. The county executive is hereby authorized to enter into and execute the attached effluent transfer system franchise contract dated February 19, 1986, in the upper left hand corner, for the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle, which by this reference is incorporated herein as part of the motion. Said franchise is granted to the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle for a term of twenty five (25) years. Said franchise to include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.

B. If within thirty (30) days after the granting of this franchise the applicant shall have failed to sign the incorporated written acceptance herein, then the herein granted rights and privileges shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
