1 A MOTION commending and congratulating
2 the Redmond Police Department for
3 achieving national recognition in
4 gaining accreditation by the
Commission of Accreditation for Law
Enforcement Agencies.

5 WHEREAS, the Redmond Police Department has gained
6 accreditation from an organization of national police agencies,
7 and

8 WHEREAS, to gain this recognition, Redmond Police had to
9 meet 817 standards established by the national organization
10 covering virtually every aspect of police work, ranging from
11 police chases to record keeping, and

12 WHEREAS, in gaining accreditation, Redmond joins a small
13 group of 29 police departments in the nation to be granted such
14 status by the commission, and

15 WHEREAS, Redmond is to be congratulated further as the first
16 city in the State of Washington to gain accreditation by the
17 commission, and

18 WHEREAS, the Redmond Police Department has worked for 14
19 months, or about 2,300 work hours to write and perfect police
20 policies to address all areas of operation, and

21 WHEREAS, the citizens of Redmond and King County will be the
22 beneficiaries of the efforts of the Redmond Police Department to
23 gain excellence, productivity and professionalism;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 The Redmond Police Department is to be recognized for its
26 achievements in gaining accreditation from the Commission on
27 Accreditation and is to be congratulated for this well-earned
28 honor.
