MOTION NO. 6635

A MOTION to reconsider a condition of approval of a reclassification petitioned by Herb Short et al. and approved by Ordinance 5914 and designated Building and Land Development File No. 202-82-R.

WHEREAS, the county council adopted Ordinance 5914 on March 15, 1982 approving the reclassification of a 1.03 acre parcel located in the Tahoma Raven Heights Community Plan area from G to MP-P, and

WHEREAS, a condition of approval of the reclassification prohibited direct access onto SR 169, a position advanced by the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT), and

WHEREAS, WSDOT now believes that access from this parcel directly onto SR 169 is the safest and most desirable and entered into an agreement with the property owner in 1985 to build the access, and

WHEREAS, WSDOT says that it is not clear if there was an understanding by the state about the location of the access prior to the granting of the reclassification in 1982, and

WHEREAS, the county council desires to review this condition of approval in the interests of public safety, and

WHEREAS, the criterion for reconsideration set forth in King County Code 20.24.250 A is met,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The zoning and subdivision examiner is directed to conduct a public hearing on the applicant's request for reconsideration of this access prohibition onto SR 169, notify all parties of record of the public hearing date, and report his findings and recommendations to the council sitting as the land use appeals committee.
