WHEREAS, the project would be scheduled for completion in January 1987, and

WHEREAS, a steering committee composed of representatives of the Cities of Tacoma and Fife, the Ports of Seattle and Tacoma, Pierce and King County, Washington State Department of Transportation, would oversee the project, and
