A MOTION related to the Vashon-Maury Island Park and Recreation District; authorizing the Executive to obligate up to \$106,500 for the acquisition of the Lisabeula property.

WHERE, the State Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation (IAC) is empowered to make grants of up to \$150,000 to support acquisition of park and recreation facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Vashon-Maury Island Park and Recreation District has applied to the IAC for acquisition of the 5.5 acre Lisabuela property, and

WHEREAS, the Real Property Division has proved an option of value totaling \$256,500 which will require a local share of \$106,500, and

WHEREAS, the Vashon-Maury Island Park and Recreation District will seek funding through passage of a proposed operating levy at a special election in February 1987, and

WHEREAS, the IAC requires that a local share be identified as available at least 30 days prior to its annual funding meeting or by October 10, 1986, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

ATTEST:

The executive is authorized to obligate King County to an amount not to exceed \$106,500 from previously uncommitted revenues for the acquisition of the 5.5 acre Lisabeula property on Vashon Island provided that,

- A. The IAC agrees to fund the acquisition at \$150,000; and
- B. The Lisabeula property shall be owned and maintained by the Vashon-Maury Island Park and Recreation District; and
- C. The February 1987 special election for consideration of a Vashon-Maury Island Park and Recreation District operating levy is passed by the voters; and
- D. If approved, the Vashon-Maury Island Park and Recreation District shall provide for repayment of all King County funds up to the \$106,500 authorized by this motion.
