PROPOSED NO. 86-619

MOTION NO. 6651

A MOTION declaring the existence of an emergency requiring immediate construction of a stormwater lagoon at Cedar Hills and waiving the requirements of competitive bidding for the construction of the stormwater lagoon.

WHEREAS, the federal court ordered King County to attack problems identified in the Cedar Hills Existing Area Report as expeditiously as the necessary planning will permit, and

WHEREAS, King County has committed to the federal court to complete this construction in 1986, and

WHEREAS, such construction must begin immediately in order to guarantee completion in 1986, and

WHEREAS, the ordinary requirements for formal competitive bidding of the construction contract for such work must be waived in order to prevent delay in beginning such construction, and

WHEREAS, the council has previously approved the project in Ordinance 7689, and

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WHEREAS, Ordinance 4551 and K.C.C. 4.16.040 permit waiver of the requirements of bidding by motion of the King County council upon declaration of an emergency and where the public interest or property of King County would suffer material injury or damage by delay;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County council declares an emergency exists and the public interest will suffer material injury and damage if the construction of a stormwater lagoon is delayed.

B. The ordinary requirements for formal competitive bidding of the construction contracts necessary for such work are hereby waived.
