MOTION NO. 6658

A MOTION directing the clerk of the council to schedule a public hearing by the council to afford the public an opportunity to speak on the adequacy of the Kent Highlands Landfill closure environmental impact statement prior to the council's decision whether to approve a final interlocal agreement with the City of Seattle to accept Seattle's solid waste at the Cedar Hills Landfill.

WHEREAS, the final Kent Highlands Landfill Closure Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) will be issued by Seattle on October 31, 1986, and

WHEREAS, King County raised several concerns and questions regarding the adequacy of the draft EIS, and

WHEREAS, a determination must be made concerning the adequacy of Seattle's responses to the county's questions and concerns in the final EIS, and

WHEREAS, if conditions warrant, a supplemental EIS may be required to be prepared by the county, and

WHEREAS, such determinations must be made prior to council approval of an interlocal agreement with Seattle permitting Seattle's use of the Cedar Hills Landfill, and

WHEREAS, Motion No. 6648 directed the executive to prepare such an interlocal agreement for review and approval by the council, and

WHEREAS, the public has not been afforded the opportunity to express their concerns before the council thus far in the council's deliberations on these issues;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The clerk of the council is directed to set a date for a council public hearing concerning the adequacy of the Kent Highlands Landfill Closure Final EIS at a date following October 31, 1986 and before the Council's decision whether to approve a final interlocal agreement with the City of Seattle to accept Seattle's solid waste at the Cedar Hills Landfill.
