## MOTION NO. <u>6671</u>

A MOTION in support of an Urban Development Action Grant (UDAG) application from the City of Black Diamond to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), supporting Black Diamond's application for a UDAG for a coal preparation facility.

WHEREAS, economic development is a priority of the King County executive and the King County council, and

WHEREAS, a public economic development program is defined as those public actions which help to promote an improved local economy and business environment, and

WHEREAS, economic development strategies are those public actions which aid in creating jobs, enhancing general business activity, and increasing communities' tax bases, increasing per capita income, and

WHEREAS, King County has previously recognized in Motion 6012 that the retention of existing businesses and the expansion of existing businesses and the revitalization of existing communities is a priority, and

WHEREAS, the King County executive proposed and the King County council funded the 1986 Economic Development Program, and

WHEREAS, one of the elements of the Economic Development Program is the identification of and packaging of UDAG grants for King County communities and King County staff have prepared the UDAG application for Black Diamond, and

WHEREAS, Black Diamond is identified as a rural activity center in the King County Comprehensive Plan - 1985, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Black Diamond and Black Diamond City Council and Pacific Coast Coal Company, Inc. have worked together to propose the coal preparation facility which will revitalize Black Diamond, and

WHEREAS, the UDAG grant of \$550,000 is necessary and appropriate to construct the \$3.7 million coal preparation facility and to create 65 jobs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The council of King County supports the Mayor and City Council of Black Diamond in their UDAG application for the coal preparation facility to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
