A MOTION supporting the King County Aging Program in its request for Ford Foundation and Harvard University funding for a van and mobile health unit to serve senior citizens in South King County.

WHEREAS, the Ford Foundation and Harvard University are sponsoring the second year of its awards program for innovations in state and local government, and

WHEREAS, such a grant request must be submitted by a governmental jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, the South King County Milti-Service Center needs a van and health unit trailer to provide mobile podiatry and preventative health care for senior citizens in South King County, based on a two to three month waiting list of appointments for podiatry care, and

WHEREAS, the South King County Multi-Service Center serves handicapped, low income and senior populations in a 500 square mile area, and

WHEREAS, the King County health department is limited in its ability to provide such service, and

WHEREAS, the mobile health unit would provide much more efficient and effective preventative health care than the present Multi-Service Center program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Aging Program is supported in its request for Ford Foundation and Harvard University funding to support a van and health unit trailer to serve senior citizens as required in the grant application.
