MOTION NO. 6696

A MOTION establishing an Interjurisdictional Task Force to identify critical public safety issues and to advise the County Council on ways to improve regional crime prevention and law enforcement.

WHEREAS, the King County Council's Operations, Justice and Human Services Committee and the Seattle City Council's Public Safety Committee met jointly on October 14, 1986 to discuss public safety issues of concern to both jurisdictions, and

WHEREAS, the joint committee found that problems in crime prevention and law enforcement increasingly cross jurisdictional boundaries, and

WHEREAS, successful joint public safety efforts such as E-911 have occurred and have benefitted both incorporated and unincorporated parts of the county, and

WHEREAS, the County Council seeks to bring together policy makers, law enforcement experts and citizens to discuss and plan for improvements to the regional public safety system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

There is hereby established an Interjurisdictional Task Force on Crime Prevention and Law Enforcement.

To ensure a broad representation of views and interests, the Task Force shall seek to include representation from the following officials or organizations:

- 1 King County Executive
- 2 Mayor of Seattle
- 3 King County Councilmember
- 4 Seattle City Councilmember
- 5 Representative of the Suburban Cities Association
- 6 Director of King County Department of Public Safety
- 7 City of Seattle Chief of Police
- 8 Representatives of the King County Police Chiefs Association
- 9 King County Prosecutor
- 10 Seattle City Attorney
- 11 Representative of the Washington Council on Crime and
- 12 Delinquency
- 13 Representative of the Seattle/King County Municipal League
- 14 Four Citizen Representatives appointed by Mayor and County
- 15 Executive.
