MOTION NO. 6683

A MOTION authorizing an interlocal agreement for raising and stabilizing the existing Lakehurst Channel adjacent to an existing 12-inch sanitary sewer line between King County and King County Water District No. 107.

WHEREAS, King County department of public works and Water District No. 107 (District) staff have developed an interlocal agreement for the Lakehurst Ravine Pipe Stabilization Project, and

WHEREAS, the proposed interlocal agreement would allow King County to contribute \$22,000 toward stabilizing the existing Lakehurst Channel and protecting a 12-inch sanitary sewer line owned by the District, and

WHEREAS, the District declared this work an emergency following the January 18, 1986 storm and has completed the construction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County: The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with King County Water District No. 107 for stabilizing the Lakehurst Channel and protecting a 12-inch sanitary sewer line based upon the terms specified in the interlocal agreement, which is attached as Exhibit A to this motion.
