2 A MOTION in support of an Economic Development  
3 Administration (EDA) grant application from the  
4 City of Snoqualmie to the United States Department  
5 of Commerce (DOC) supporting Snoqualmie's application  
6 for a public works grant for an industrial utility  
7 extension project.

8 WHEREAS, economic development is a priority of the King County  
9 executive and the King County council, and

10 WHEREAS, a public economic development program is defined as those  
11 public actions which help to promote an improved local economy and  
12 business environment, and

13 WHEREAS, economic development strategies are those public actions  
14 which aid in creating jobs, enhancing general business activity, and  
15 increasing communities' tax bases, increasing per capita income, and

16 WHEREAS, King County has previously recognized in Motion 6012  
17 that the retention of existing businesses and the expansion of existing  
18 businesses and the revitalization of existing communities is a priority,  
19 and

20 WHEREAS, the King County executive proposed and the King County  
21 council funded the 1987 Economic Development Program, and

22 WHEREAS, one of the elements of the Economic Development Program  
23 is the identification of and packaging of EDA grants for King County  
24 communities and King County staff have assisted in the preparation  
25 of the EDA application for Snoqualmie, and

26 WHEREAS, Snoqualmie is identified as a rural activity center in  
27 the King County Comprehensive Plan - 1985, and

28 WHEREAS, the Mayor of Snoqualmie and the Snoqualmie City Council  
29 and private businesses have worked together to propose the utility  
30 extension project which will revitalize Snoqualmie, and

31 WHEREAS, the EDA grant of \$558,750 is necessary and appropriate  
32 to support the \$13 million in private investment and to create 172  
33 jobs;
