WHEREAS, the tribe has indicated that they would like to receive solid waste from King County to support that energy/resource recovery facility, and

WHEREAS, the Tulalip Indian Tribe has land available and has already contracted with a vendor for construction and operation of their proposed energy/resource recovery facility and plans to have the facility begin operations in 1990, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of King County to preserve landfill capacity by utilizing other disposal options, such as energy/resource recovery, and

WHEREAS, none of the energy/resource recovery options under consideration by King County could be operational prior to 1992,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

The executive is requested to investigate the Tulalip Indian energy/resource recovery proposal and report to the council by May 1, 1987 on the following:

A. Specific details of the proposal, including but not limited to proposed technology, amount of tonnage requested, proposed timing for delivery, tipping fees, method and location of ash disposal, and proposed contract terms;
