A MOTION authorizing the conveyance of a portion of King County right-of-way to the State of Washington (SR 99, Redondo to Seattle)

WHEREAS, King County is the record owner of a county road lying within the right-of-way for a state road project (SR 99, Redondo to Seattle), and

WHEREAS, in the construction of the aforesaid state road project, it is necessary and advisable for the State of Washington to acquire title to all county road rights-of-way lying within the right-of-way of the aforesaid highway project, and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the council of King County deems it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of King county and the State of Washington that King county convey said county road rights-of-way that abut SR99, (Redondo to Seattle), to the State of Washington by Quit Claim Deed for the consideration of mutual benefits;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to execute, on behalf of the citizens of King county, the necessary instruments in order to convey the following described rights-of-way and deliver the same to the State of Washington.

(SR99), Redondo to Seattle, (Junction South 288th Street to South 260th Street). All county road right-of-way, together with all appurtenances thereto located within the project limits.
